Southern New Hampshire 'Guaranteed No-Rain' Tour

Saturday, September 19, 2026

September's Autoneers tour will take you back in time as we'll drive primarily on country roads. Late Summer in New Hampshire is a beautiful time of year, and we've put in a special request for ideal open car touring weather. Many towns in the area feature a plethora of unpaved roads and you'll get to enjoy some nice ones.

Our day begins with coffee, goodies, tire-kicking and commiserating about our latest old car challenges. We'll also have bottled water for you to take along on your journey.

Next, we'll pass through some choice scenery to visit [Frye's Measure Mill](#) in Wilton. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the water powered mill has been in operation for nearly 170 years. Several rooms offer the oval and round boxes for sale, made at the mill, along with other items. There's an optional \$7 fee to view the 'mill'.

After lunch at Grill 603 in Milford, more scenic roads, a photo op at an old-time gas station in Amherst, plus an obligatory ice cream stop. Prior to loading-up at the end of the tour, y'all are welcome to come to our house for some good ol' tire kickin'.

**** IMPORTANT **** We are awaiting approval to use the school's parking area. If not approved, parking will be at the alternate location, Silver Lake State Park – stay tuned. Please check the [Autoneers website](#) for updates. If you have any questions, please call Adam or Jeannette.
- It's easiest to use an entrance not immediately next to the trailer parking area, then approach the parking area as shown. You may also go around the back side of the school buildings. **BE AWARE** that there's one spot where there's an overhang and negotiating with a trailer requires your attention.
- **Overflow parking area:** If we run short of parking, one mile north on Silver Lake Road (Rt 122) is the parking lot for Silver Lake State Park. There's plenty of parking space there. Park along the back two rows, farthest from the road. The parking area is hard-packed dirt.
- The speed limit in Hollis, unless otherwise posted, is 30 MPH. Best to stick close to the posted limit, lest you win an invitation to the Policeman's Ball.
- On Broad Street (Rt 130), just off Silver Lake Road (Rt 122) there's a [24 hour Sunoco](#) gas station. The pumps to the left of the station building are easiest to access with a tow vehicle and trailer. With a trailer, drive around the back side building (bumpy parking lot) to exit onto Broad Street (left turn), then right turn at the traffic light onto Rt 122 north, to Hollis Primary School or Silver Lake parking.
- **Arrive between 7:45AM and 9:00AM for coffee and carbs. Depart HPS around 9:15.**

Total Mileage: About 60 miles

Fuel: Please depart with a full tank. The first gasoline (or water for steam cars) opportunity will be about 30 miles on the tour.

Noteworthy: Hollis' Old Home Day parade is the same day as our tour. Rt 122, south of Rt 130 may be closed, so getting into or out of the Sunoco station could be tricky. Best to arrive already fueled-up.
